<b>Profile title</b>	<b>BIOETHICIST</b>
<b>Role</b>	Analyses ethical components of real or potential health care actions/decisions, and provides an ethical justification supporting specific actions or decisions.
<b>Minimal requirements</b>	An advanced degree in a field such as: medicine, nursing, social work, genetics, or law; Advanced degrees or certification courses in bioethics; At least <b>3</b> years professional experience.
<b>Professional competences:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Providing support to staff, physicians, patients and their family members in dealing with ethical issues in a patient's care.</li> <li>- Reasonable, fair and transparent boundaries exist when individual preferences affect others.</li> <li>- Mediation occurs to help identify common interests and resolve conflicts when parties disagree about patient care.</li> <li>- Knowledge of the legal and ethical aspects in connection to the people's rights in the field of oncogenetics</li> </ul>
<b>Transversal competences:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Engaged in organizational ethics activities (such as the development of policies, procedures and guidelines) to help prevent or manage ethical issues in patient care.</li> <li>2. Engaged in educational activities organized for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Staff and physicians</li> <li>-Health care students and trainees within the organization</li> <li>-University students in relevant disciplines</li> </ul> </li> <li>3.
